



THRACE THYRRHENIAN SEA Now when some days had passed, Agrippa the king and Bernice arrived at Caesarea and greeted Festus. And as they stayed there many days, Festus laid Paul's case before the king, saying, "There is Gatanas a man left prisoner by Felix, and when I was at Jerusalem, the chief Syracuse priests and the elders of the Jews laid out their case against him, C.Pinhvnus asking for a sentence of condemnation against him. I answered them that it was not the custom of the Romans to give up anyone before the accused met the accusers face to face and had opportunity to make his defense concerning the charge laid against him. THRACE RRHENIAN SEA So when they came together here, I made no delay, but on the next day took my seat on the tribunal and ordered the man to be brought. When the accusers stood up, they brought no charge in his case of such evils as I supposed. Rather they had certain points of Gatana dispute with him about their own religion and about a certain Jesus, C.Pinhvnus who was dead, but whom Paul asserted to be alive. Being at a loss how to investigate these questions, I asked whether he wanted to go to Jerusalem and be tried there regarding them. But when Paul had appealed to be kept in custody for the decision of the emperor, MAP I ordered him to be held until I could send him to Caesar." 

For I am persuaded that none of these things has escaped his notice, for this has not been done in a corner. King Agrippa, do you believe the prophets? I know that you believe." And Agrippa said to Paul, "In a short time would you persuade me to be a Christian?" And Paul said, "Whether short or long, I would to God that not only you but also all who hear me this day might become such as I am — except for these chains." The only leap that the New Testament calls us to make is not into the Gatanas Syracuse darkness but out of the darkness into the light, into that which C.Pinchynns we can indeed understand. That is not to say that everything the Bulshay O R Christian faith speaks of is manifestly clear with respect to rational categories. I can't understand, for example, how a person can have a divine nature and a human nature at the same time, which is what we believe about Jesus. THRACE RRHE SEA Mystery doesn't apply only to religion. I don't understand the ultimate force of gravity. These things are mysterious to us, but they're not irrational. It's one thing to say, 'I don't understand Gatanas from my finite mind how these things work out,' and it's another Syracuse thing to say, 'They're blatantly contradictory and irrational, but C.Pinhvnus I'm going to believe them anyway.' That's not what Christianity BrakeBoy O D does. Christianity says that there are mysteries, but those mysteries cannot be articulated in terms of the irrational; if that were so, then we have moved away from Christian truth."
